Job Details: freelance position, working from home

In addition, Anthem FFWD>> Members are encouraged to get involved in other opportunities working on Anthem events and activity, and opportunities offered by our partners Beacons.

1. About Anthem

Anthem. Music Fund Wales Cronfa Gerdd Cymru is a new charity established in 2018.

Our vision - A Wales in which music can empower every young life.

- We believe music is a potent creative force for young people that feeds self-expression, personal development and wellbeing.
- We create opportunities across genres and communities and nurture diverse talent to take their next steps in music.
- We are a catalyst for youth music in Wales, funding work that will create change, making connections to widen partnership working, and enabling best practice to flourish.

2. What is Anthem FFWD>>?

Anthem FFWD>> gives you the chance to fast forward your personal development in music in Wales. Across the year you will receive support from Anthem, but you will also get to feed into Anthem's development, and help to fast forward change in the music industry for all young people in the future generations.

Anthem is passionate about putting young people at the heart of our work as we take our next steps. Anthem FFWD brings together a group of 17 to

24 years old's who are involved with music across genres in Wales to help them build pathways to music industry and support Anthem's work.

I've gained confidence speaking to people which is valuable as I now feel more comfortable going up to people to network and ask questions.

I feel that I have a good idea of where to start after the informative talks that I've been able to join with FFWD.

Anthem taught me that I deserve to be heard and seen, no matter my additional needs. I want to share that with others that are yet to learn it.

I've gained a sense of community, and an understanding of other people's difficulties in the industry to help guide me.

It has given me the confidence to be able to perform a song I wrote only three days after I wrote it, which I wouldn't have done before FFWD.

Most importantly I've learnt to believe in myself.

Here are the kinds of things you will get to do as part of Anthem FFWD>>:

- Work with the Anthem CEO to explore journeys through music for young people in Wales. Your views matter and we want to hear what you have to say!
- Feed into the Anthem Gateway, create content, host events and share your views and experiences of music industry in Wales.
- Meet guest speakers from across the industry talk on subjects that interest you

- Get involved in a collaborations project and have the chance to influence the music industry in Wales
- Contribute to the development of Anthem projects and represent Anthem at key music events across Wales
